Texas Short Line Railroad & Other Small Scale Short Line "Like" Operations and Infrastructure

This document is arranged in two sections: The first focused on Texas Short Line Railroads and the second focused on Other Small Scale Short Line "Like" Operations and Infrastructure. The separation of the two sections was primarily based on if the "railroad" had a listed 260 Number. This is an effort to maintain a more in depth listing of the short line "like" railroads and related rail infrastructure that normally would not be tracked.

Information is collected from a variety of sources (telephone calls, emails, previous reports and state plans, railroad websites, railroad provided surveys, railroad provided maps, and FRA and TxDOT GIS data).

Texas Short Line Railroad Mapping

Railroad map data was inconsistent and what was obtained should not be considered precise and be used for reference only. Some railroads provided: links to online maps, detailed maps, rough map sketches, word descriptions of their lines. For railroads not providing additional maps, sketches were developed based on a combination of FRA and TxDOT GIS data, Google Maps, railroad websites, and email word descriptions. **All inputs, related to the list of 50 Short Line Railroads, were compiled and included in the TxDOT State Railroad Map 2023 produced by TTI.**

Other Small Scale Short Line "Like" Operations and Infrastructure Mapping

This type of rail infrastructure track may be identified or not identified on TxDOT or FRA mapping. Some may be considered industrial leads. It is typically not identified by name. Any map references listed in the latter section are strictly to provide basic locations.
