ALL Districts

The Texas Transportation Commission (commission) desires to award funds to support the continued development of coordinated regional planning in public transportation.

The commission adopted Minute Order 111883 on July 30, 2009 awarding \$1.32 million in Federal Transit Administration (FTA) §5304 grant funds and state matching funds to lead agencies for coordinated regional public transportation planning.

To clarify the public record, the commission rescinds and withdraws Minute Order 111883 dated July 30, 2009.

Transportation Code, Chapter 455 assigns a broad spectrum of public transportation roles and missions to the Texas Department of Transportation (department).


Transportation Code, Chapter 456 authorizes the commission to administer funds appropriated for public transportation.

Under USC §5304, the FTA provides the department with funds to be used for planning and coordination projects. Federal funding to be used in FY 2010 has already been appropriated by Congress and apportioned by the FTA. Funding to be used in FY 2011 is expected to be appropriated by Congress and apportioned by the FTA in amounts sufficient to sustain this award, but this minute order does not guarantee the availability of funds in FY 2011.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the commission that Minute Order 111883, dated July 30, 2009, is rescinded and withdrawn.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the commission that the executive director or the director's designee is authorized to distribute the funds as described in Exhibit A, submit the necessary state application to the FTA, and enter into the necessary contracts in accordance with the priorities established in this minute order.
