The Historically Underutilized Business (HUB) Program was developed by the Texas Department of Transportation (department), under authority of Transportation Code, §201.702, and intended to be consistent where practicable with both Government Code, Chapter 2161, and the department's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise and Small Business Enterprise programs.

Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, §9.54, requires the Texas Transportation Commission to establish annual goals for HUB participation in state- and locally-funded contracts (other than highway construction and maintenance contracts). The goals are set based on a percentage of the total costs of these contracts, the most current state disparity study described in Government Code §2162.002(c), and availability of HUBs. Accordingly, the current annual goals are as follows: 26.1 percent for building construction contracts; 57.2 percent for special trade contracts; 20 percent for professional services contracts; 33 percent for other service contracts and 12.6 percent for commodity purchases.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the HUB goals stated in this order are effective for Fiscal Year 2011.
