1. **Public Hearing**  
2012 Unified Transportation Program (UTP) - Receive data, comments, views, and testimony concerning the 2012 UTP ([Report](#))  
*The UTP is a 10-year statewide plan for transportation project development. The purpose of this public hearing is to accept comments on the 2012 UTP. The department opened a 30-day review and comment period on April 8th when the notice of hearing was published in the Texas Register. Written comments will be accepted until May 9th at 5:00 PM. The commission will consider final adoption of the 2012 UTP at the May 26th meeting.*
2. **Approval of Minutes** of the March 31 regular meeting and the April 12 special meeting of the Texas Transportation Commission
3. **Discussion Items**
  - a. Update on TxDOT's modernization project ([MO](#))  
*At the February commission meeting, senior staff was assigned to lead TxDOT's Modernization Initiative based on the implementation of the Restructure Council's recommendations. An update will be presented on the status of this initiative.*
  - b. Update on nationwide initiatives related to the use of vehicle mileage fee systems ([Report](#))  
*A research team from the Texas Transportation Institute will present an update of nationwide initiatives in the advancement of vehicle mileage fee legislation, policy, technology, and pilot projects. A representative from the Minnesota pilot project that uses the most technically advanced architecture will be present to provide an overview of the pilot study scope, implementation schedule, and desired outcomes.*

4. **Aviation**  
**112656 Various Counties** – Award federal and state grant funding for airport improvement projects at various locations (MO)  
*Federal law authorizes the award of federal funding to preserve and improve the state's general aviation system. State law authorizes the award of state funding for capital improvement projects. The airports listed in Exhibit A are eligible for award of these grant funds and the department seeks approval of the awards.*
5. **Promulgation of Administrative Rules** Under Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, and the Administrative Procedure Act, Government Code, Chapter 2001:
- a. **Final Adoption**  
**112657 (1) Chapter 1 - Management (MO)**  
Amendments to §1.85, Department Advisory Committees (Advisory Committees)  
*The rule creates a strategic research oversight advisory committee that will give advice and recommendations to the department on the selection of strategic research and the selection of entities to carry out that research. The advisory committee's members will consist of various members of the transportation industry as deemed appropriate by the commission.*
- 112658 (2) Chapter 7 - Rail Facilities and Chapter 31 Public Transportation (MO)**  
New §7.80, Purpose, §7.81, Definitions, §7.82, Program Standard, §7.83, System Safety Program Plan, §7.84, System Security Plan, §7.85, Reviews, §7.86, Accident Notification and Corrective Action Plans, §7.87, Deadlines, and §7.88, Admissibility; Use of Information (Rail Fixed Guideway System State Safety Oversight Program); Amendments to §31.2, Organization, and §31.3, Definitions (General); Amendments to §31.48, Project Oversight (Program Administration); Repeal of Subchapter F, Rail Fixed Guideway System State Safety Oversight Program, §§31.60 - 31.63  
*The repeals concern the rail fixed guideway system state safety oversight program. The repeals are made because the program has been transferred from the Public Transportation Division to the Railroad Division. The provisions on the state oversight program for rail fixed guideway systems are moved to Chapter 7, new Subchapter E.*
- 112659 (3) Chapter 25 - Traffic Operations (MO)**  
Amendments to §25.901, Purpose, §25.902, Definitions, §25.903, Scope, and §25.906, Participation (Traffic Safety Program)  
*The proposed rules require entities that receive funds under traffic safety program grant agreements to adopt and enforce internal compliance programs that satisfy the ethical standard provisions in commission rules. To provide entities that do not currently have compliance programs time to comply with the new requirement, the requirement applies only to agreements that are entered into after January 1, 2012.*
- b. **Proposed Adoption**  
**112660 Chapter 9 - Contract and Grant Management (MO)**  
Amendments to §9.42, Administrative Qualification (Contracting for Architectural, Engineering, and Surveying Services)  
*These amendments change the deadline for submission of information regarding administrative qualifications to reduce the administrative qualifications burden on firms with smaller contracts or those who have a smaller participation in large contracts.*

- 112661 6. **Audit Subcommittee**  
Approve changes to the charter of the Texas Transportation Commission Audit Subcommittee (MO)  
*The Audit Subcommittee was created to oversee and ensure compliance with the intent of Sarbanes-Oxley as to reliability and transparency in financial reporting, as well as to ensure the independence of the department's internal audit program by providing oversight of the internal auditor and evaluating implementation of audit recommendations. The charter sets out the purpose and composition of the Subcommittee, as well as meeting requirements and principal duties and responsibilities of the Subcommittee in carrying out its oversight role. The Subcommittee is required to review and assess the adequacy of the charter annually and request commission approval for proposed changes.*
- 112662 7. **Proposition 12 Bond Program**  
**Bexar County** – Revise the funding allocation for a previously approved highway improvement project and approve an additional highway improvement project to be funded with the proceeds of general obligation bonds issued under Transportation Code, Section 222.004 (Proposition 12 Bonds) (MO)  
*In Minute Order 112036, dated November 19, 2009, the commission approved the expenditure of Proposition 12 bonds proceeds on a selected list of projects. The commission is revising the funding allocation for one of the projects from the previously approved list and transferring some of those funds to an additional project.*
- 112663 8. **Unified Transportation Program (UTP)**  
a. Approve updates to FY 2011 funding allocations in the 2010 UTP (MO)  
*The UTP is a 10-year statewide plan for transportation project development. The 2010 UTP, which was approved by the commission in April 2010, established funding levels by category and by district. To more effectively manage available funding and optimize construction and maintenance project lettings, the commission adopted Minute Order 112531, dated December 16, 2010, which adjusted the FY 2011, FY 2012, FY 2013 and FY 2014 district/category allocations. This minute order further updates FY 2011 funding levels to account for changes to district allocations based on the distribution of available commission discretionary funds.*
- 112664 b. **Bexar County - Authorize CONSTRUCT authority for the Wurzbach Parkway project in Category 12, Strategic Priority (MO)**  
*To more effectively manage available funding and optimize construction and maintenance project lettings, the commission adopted Minute Order 112531, dated December 16, 2010, which adjusted the FY 2011, FY 2012, FY 2013 and FY 2014 district/category allocations. This minute order authorizes the use of Category 12 funds allocated to the San Antonio District by MO 112531 on the Wurzbach Parkway project.*
- 112665 9. **State Highway 99 (Grand Parkway)**  
a. Appoint a member to the Grand Parkway Association Board of Directors (MO)  
*State law requires transportation corporations to have a board in which the powers of the corporation reside. The commission shall appoint each director for a term not to exceed six years. The Grand Parkway Association has nominated the prospective director and submitted the required application, financial statement, and letter of reference. This minute order appoints one member to the board.*

- 112666 9. **State Highway 99 (Grand Parkway) (continued)**  
b. **Fort Bend County** – Authorize the department to enter into an agreement with Fort Bend County pursuant to Transportation Code, §228.0111, for the use of state-owned right of way by Fort Bend County to develop, construct, and operate the portion of the Grand Parkway toll project from US 59 to just north of FM 1093 as part of the Fort Bend County road system (MO)  
*Transportation Code, §228.0111 gives Fort Bend County the first option to develop, construct, and operate the portion of the Grand Parkway project between US 59 and FM 1093. Fort Bend County has exercised that option. Section 228.0111(k) requires the department to assist Fort Bend County in the development, financing, construction, and operation of a project for which the county has exercised its option by allowing the county to use state highway right of way owned by the department and to access the state highway system.*
- 112667 10. **State Infrastructure Bank (SIB)**  
**Final Approval**  
a. El Paso County – **Camino Real Regional Mobility Authority (CRRMA)**  
Consider granting final approval of an application from the CRRMA to borrow up to \$20 million from the SIB to pay for a portion of the costs of constructing Loop 375 mainlanes from Business 54 to US 54 in El Paso County (MO)  
*The CRRMA is requesting a SIB loan to pay a portion of the costs of constructing the Loop 375 (Northeast) mainlane extension project from Business 54 to US 54, converting an existing six-lane divided urban collector into an urban freeway with frontage roads. The project includes the design, development, and construction of four mainlanes between existing frontage roads, providing grade separations at the US 54 underpass, Kenworthy Drive, Rushing Boulevard, and Alcan Street.*
- 112668 b. El Paso County – **Camino Real Regional Mobility Authority (CRRMA)**  
Consider granting final approval of an application from the CRRMA to borrow up to \$20 million from the SIB to pay for a portion of the costs of constructing two direct connectors at the Loop 375/FM 659 interchange in the city of El Paso (MO)  
*The CRRMA is requesting a SIB loan to pay for a portion of the costs of constructing two direct connectors to and from Loop 375, El Paso's regional beltway surrounding the metropolitan area and FM 659, a major thoroughfare in the city. The project also includes various related interchange improvements and traffic management systems improvements.*
11. **Obligation Limit Report**  
Status report on the FY 2011 Obligation Limit, the actual obligations utilized through the current month, proposed remaining highway maintenance and construction contract letting for the fiscal year and an update on motor fuel tax receipts  
*This report will provide the current overall obligation status, by district, of the FY 2011 Obligation Limit and will also provide the anticipated effect on the obligation limit of remaining proposed highway maintenance and construction letting. The report will also provide an update on motor fuel tax receipts, including estimated versus actual receipts fiscal year to date, and any potential impact on letting volume.*

*These proposed minute orders contain information concerning the receipt of bids for highway improvement contracts. The department may reschedule receipt of bids for those projects where the commission rejects all bids. Those bids accepted by the commission will result in conditional contract awards to the low bidders. Contract award conditions may involve securing funding from other sources, the contractor's ability to satisfy federal DBE subcontracting requirements, or other requirements as outlined in the project bid proposal*

- 112671 a. **Eminent Domain Proceedings**  
**Various Counties** – non-controlled and controlled access highways (see attached itemized list) (MO)  
*Commission findings, determinations, and authorizations for the state to acquire by eminent domain, upon the payment of adequate and just compensation, various ownership interests in specific parcels of real property that are needed to develop or improve both non-controlled and controlled access state highways, to include requesting the state attorney general to bring and pursue condemnation suits relating to those specific parcels of real property described in the attached itemized list, for which negotiations with the property owners were unsuccessful.*
- b. **Load Zones & Postings**  
*These minute orders authorize the placement, revision, or removal of load postings on various roadways and bridges on the state-maintained highway system.*
- 112672 (1) **Roadways - Various Counties** – Revise load restrictions on roadways on the state highway system (MO)
- 112673 (2) **Bridges - Various Counties** – Revise load restrictions on bridges on the state highway system (MO)
- c. **Finance**
- 112674 (1) **Accept the Quarterly Cash Report (MO)**  
*This minute order approves the quarterly cash report relating to the cash receipts and disbursements of the department. The report is required by statute and was prepared using a cash basis of accounting.*
- 112675 (2) **Accept the Quarterly Investment Report (MO)**  
*This minute order accepts the quarterly investment report for investments of funds relating to financing of the Central Texas Turnpike System and held by the Bank of New York Mellon, acting as trustee.*
- d. **Right of Way Dispositions and Donations**  
*The commission must approve the sales, transfers and exchanges of state rights of way and other real properties that are no longer needed for a state highway purpose. It must also approve, accept and acknowledge donations to the state of real property that is valued at \$500 or more.*
- 112676 (1) **Dallas County - SH 114 at N. Airfield Drive in Irving - Consider the sale of surplus right of way to the cities of Dallas and Fort Worth (MO)**  
*The district has advised that the surplus land is no longer needed for highway purposes. It may be sold to the cities.*

d. **Right of Way Dispositions and Donations (continued)**

- 112677 (2) **Fort Bend County** - US 90A at FM 1092 in Stafford - Consider the amendment of Minute Order 110130, dated June 30, 2005, to correct the legal descriptions and revise the values of surplus and new easements being exchanged (MO)  
*The district has advised that the two easements were surveyed incorrectly. This minute order amends the legal descriptions with the correct legal descriptions and amends the values of the surplus easement and new easement.*
- 112678 (3) **Hays County** - I-35 at Centerpoint Road in San Marcos - Consider the sale of surplus right of way to the abutting landowners (MO)  
*The district has advised that the surplus land is no longer needed for highway purposes. It may be sold to the abutting landowners.*
- 112679 (4) **Hidalgo County** - Old alignment of BUS 281W (Tourist Drive) in Edinburg - Consider the quitclaim of surplus right of way to the City of Edinburg (MO)  
*The district has advised that the surplus land is no longer needed for highway purposes. No record title has been found in the states name, and the surplus land may be quitclaimed to the city.*
- 112680 (5) **Hood County** - FM 4 at US 377 east of Granbury - Consider the sale of surplus right of way to the abutting landowner (MO)  
*The district has advised that the surplus land is no longer needed for highway purposes. It may be sold to the abutting landowner.*
- 112681 (6) **Schleicher County** - US 190 east of the Crockett County line - Consider the quitclaim of surplus right of way to honor a reversionary clause (MO)  
*As a result of highway realignment, the district has determined that a portion of the land is no longer needed for highway purposes. The instrument of conveyance to the state contains a clause to the effect that if the highway is permanently abandoned, it will revert to the grantor.*
- 112682 (7) **Tarrant County** - I-30 at Center Street in Arlington - Consider the sale of surplus right of way to the abutting landowner (MO)  
*The district has advised that the surplus land is no longer needed for highway purposes. It may be sold to the abutting landowner.*

- 112683 e. **Highway Designations**  
**Cameron County** – Correct the description of the new location of FM 732 in and near the city of San Benito as set out in Minute Orders 109918 and 109919, dated December 16, 2004, and rescind the removal of a portion of FM 732 described in MO 109919 (MO)  
*MO 109918 and 109919 incorrectly described the location of a new alignment of FM 732. MO 109919 also incorrectly removed a portion of the existing alignment of FM 732 when it should have been redesignated FM 1577, as ordered in MO 109918. This minute order corrects the description of the new location of FM 732 and rescinds the portion of MO 109919 that removes a portion of the existing location of FM 732 from FM 1577 to approximately 0.3 mile east of the intersection of FM 1577 from the state highway system.*

- 112684 f. **Speed Zones**  
**Various Counties** – Establish or alter regulatory and construction speed zones on various sections of highways in the state (MO)  
*This minute order establishes or alters regulatory and construction speed zones on various sections of highways in the state.*
