With a TxTag, you will always pay the lowest toll rates in Austin and on toll roads throughout the state.

A commercial account is required if your vehicle has more than two axles or if you need more than five vehicles on one account. There's no limit to the number of TxTags you or your company can have under one commercial account. You can view toll road activity for all trucks on one account statement, and you'll only need to monitor one toll account balance.
