3.	If a 4 <sup>th</sup> contract is added, would the contract values still remain at \$3M each? Or would they be reduced to accommodate the 4 <sup>th</sup> contract?	Any added contracts to the current number of contracts would be at the same amount, \$3M.
4.	How much notice will be given by the state for required travel to districts to complete audits?	Depends on the district's need and will be negotiated during work authorization development.
5.	Will access be given through Project Wise for the audits for virtual audits – or will record keepers be required to complete at a TxDOT office for access to the records?	Depends on the district's need and will be negotiated during work authorization development.
