Consider the award or rejection of contracts for highway construction and maintenance, and construction and rehabilitation of buildings (<u>Presentation</u>)

These proposed minute orders contain information concerning the receipt of bids for highway improvement contracts. The Texas Department of Transportation may reschedule receipt of bids for those projects where the Texas Transportation Commission (commission) rejects all bids. Those bids accepted by the commission will result in conditional contract awards to the low bidders. Contract award conditions may involve securing funding from other sources, the contractor's ability to satisfy federal DBE subcontracting requirements, or other requirements as outlined in the project bid proposal.

#### 6. Legislative Appropriations Request

116751

Consider the adoption of the Texas Department of Transportation's Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Legislative Appropriations Request (Presentation) (MO)

Every two years the Texas Department of Transportation (department) is required to submit a Legislative Appropriations Request (LAR) for the upcoming biennium to be considered by the Texas Legislature. The proposed LAR describes the level of funding, method of finance, and full-time equivalents associated with the department's strategies for the Fiscal Year 2026-2027 biennium. State law requires the department to deliver the LAR to the Texas Transportation Commission in an open meeting not later than the 30th day before the date the department submits the LAR to the Legislative Budget Board and the Governor's Office.

#### 7. Unified Transportation Program

Consider the approval of the 2025 Unified Transportation Program (Presentation) (MO)

The Unified Transportation Program (UTP) is a 10-year statewide plan for transportation project development. The Project Selection Process (PSP) is approved annually and describes the funding categories and process for selecting transportation projects. This minute order approves the 2025 UTP for Fiscal Years 2025-2034, as well as the PSP for the 2025 UTP.

### Chapter 15 - Financing and Construction of Transportation Projects

Amendments to §15.188 concerning the County Transportation Infrastructure Fund Grant Program (MO)

The proposed amendments provide changes to §15.188 that conform to legislative amendments made to the Texas Transportation Code, Chapter 256, Subchapter C. The changes remove the requirement that a county must submit the county road condition report as part of the application process for consideration of being awarded a County Transportation Infrastructure Fund Grant.

  - b. Rules Adoption

(1) **Chapter 27 - Toll Projects** - Amendments to §27.80 (Definitions), §27.81 (Free Use of Turnpike Project by Military Vehicles), and §27.82 (Toll Operations) and repeal of §27.86 (Veteran Discount Program) (MO) The proposed rulemaking provides contracting flexibility for the department with respect to the operation of its toll projects. In addition, the rulemaking corrects outdated terminology and eliminates unnecessary provisions.

- (2) Chapter 28 Oversize and Overweight Vehicles and Loads
  Amendments to §28.102 (Authority's Powers and Duties) (MO)
  The amendments add specified off-system roadway segments to the roadways that the Texas Transportation Commission has authorized Hidalgo County Regional Mobility Authority (HCRMA) to issue permits for oversize and overweight vehicle travel. Amendments require that certain conditions be met before HCRMA may issue permits for travel on those off-system segments and provides that HCRMA may not issue any permits on the segments of the off-system roadway after September 30, 2025.
- 9. **Aviation** (Presentation)

a. **Aviation Capital Improvement Program** - Consider the approval of the Aviation Capital Improvement Program (MO)

The Texas Department of Transportation (department) is required to prepare and update annually a multi-year aviation facilities capital improvement program. The department is seeking the Texas Transportation Commission's approval of this program.

 Various Counites - Consider the approval of the Routine Airport Maintenance Program (MO)
 State law authorizes the award of state funding for routine airport maintenance projects.

State law authorizes the award of state funding for routine airport maintenance projects. The recommended airports are eligible for award of these grant funds and the Aviation Division seeks approval of the awards.

c. **Various Counties** - Consider the award of federal non-primary entitlement grant funding, federal apportionment grant funding, Infrastructure and Investment Jobs Act (IIJA) grant funding, and state grant funding for airport improvement projects at various locations (MO)

Federal law authorizes the award of federal non-primary entitlement grant funding, federal apportionment grant funding, and Infrastructure and Investment Jobs Act grant funding to preserve and improve the state's general aviation system. State law authorizes the award of state grant funding for capital improvement projects.

10. State Infrastructure Bank

**Various Counties -** Consider approval of applications for State Infrastructure Bank loans from various applicants (<u>Presentation</u>) (<u>MO</u>)

This minute order will authorize the executive director or their designee to enter into a financial assistance agreement with each applicant pursuant to the terms of this minute order and 43 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 6.

#### 11. Ship Channel Improvement Revolving Fund

<u>Jefferson County</u> - Sabine-Neches Navigation District - Consider approval of a request from Sabine-Neches Navigation District for a Ship Channel Improvement Revolving Fund loan in the amount of up to \$357,000,000 to provide revenue or security for its local share of qualified costs necessary to widen or deepen the Sabine Neches Waterway in Jefferson County, Texas (MO)

The Sabine-Neches Navigation District (district) will secure the loan with a pledge of User Fee revenues. The loan will be used by the district to provide revenue or security for its local share of qualified costs necessary to widen or deepen the Sabine Neches Waterway.

#### 12. Advanced Acquisition by Purchase of Right of Way

**Comal County** - Consider authorizing the negotiation and advance acquisition by purchase of right of way for possible use in, or in connection with, a transportation facility before a final decision has been made as to whether the transportation facility will be located on that property or environmental clearance has been issued for the transportation facility by the appropriate federal or state authority (MO)

State law authorizes the Texas Transportation Commission to acquire real property before a final decision is made as to the location of a transportation facility. The Texas Department of Transportation desires to purchase property on US 281 in Comal County for possible use in or in connection with a transportation facility.

#### 13. Eminent Domain Proceedings

**Various Counties** - Consider the authorization of the filing of condemnation proceedings to acquire real property by eminent domain for non-controlled and controlled access highways (see attached itemized list) (MO)

Texas Transportation Commission findings, determinations, and authorizations for the state, by motion made in accordance with Senate Bill 18 (82nd Legislature), to acquire by eminent domain, upon the payment of adequate and just compensation, various ownership interests in specific parcels of real property that are needed to develop or improve both non-controlled and controlled access state highways, to include requesting the state attorney general to bring and pursue condemnation suits relating to those specific parcels of real property described in the attached itemized list.

#### 14. Routine Minute Orders and Reports

#### a. **Donations to the Department**

116763

**Various Districts** - Consider the acknowledgment of donations with a value of \$500 or more, including donations of money, materials, services, or real property, that are made to the Texas Department of Transportation (department) for the purpose of assisting the department in carrying out its functions and duties or for improving access to or from a highway on the state highway system (see attached itemized list) (MO)

State statutes require the Texas Transportation Commission (commission) to acknowledge the acceptance of a gift to the Texas Department of Transportation that is valued at \$500 or more. By the adoption of this minute order, the commission acknowledges the receipt and acceptance of the property specified in the minute order.

#### 14. Routine Minute Orders and Reports

#### b. **Real Estate Dispositions**

The Texas Transportation Commission must approve the sales, transfers, and exchanges of state rights of way and other real properties that are no longer needed for a state highway purpose. It must also approve, accept, and acknowledge donations to the state of real property that is valued at \$500 or more.

(1) Anderson County - SH 294 - Consider the sale of right of way to an abutting landowner (MO)

The district has determined that the land is no longer needed for highway purposes. An abutting landowner has requested to purchase the land, and it may be sold to the requester.

(2) **Sherman County** - US 287 - Consider an easement release to the underlying fee owner (MO)

The district has determined that the easement is no longer needed for highway purposes. The easement may be released to the underlying fee owner.

#### c. **Reports**

#### (1) Compliance Division Report

State law requires the Texas Transportation Commission (commission) to establish a compliance program, which must include a Compliance Division to oversee the program. The Compliance Division is responsible for acting to prevent and detect serious breaches of the Texas Department of Transportation (department) policy, fraud, waste, and abuse of office, including any acts of criminal conduct within the department. The Compliance Division is required to provide a monthly report to the commission regarding investigations and a summary of information relating to trends and recommendations.

#### (2) Quarterly Investment Report

Quarterly Investment Report for all of the funds invested at the direction of the Texas Transportation Commission (Report)

This is a presentation of the quarterly investment report for the investment of: (1) funds held by the Bank of New York Mellon, as trustee, under the Indenture of Trust securing the Central Texas Turnpike System toll revenue obligations; (2) funds for the pre-paid TxTag account held by the Bank of New York Mellon, acting as custodian; (3) funds held by Amegy Bank, a Division of ZB, National Association, as trustee, under the Trust Agreement securing the I-35EManaged Lanes Project toll revenue obligations; and (4) funds held by U.S. Bank National Association, as trustee, under the Master Trust Agreement securing the SH 249 System toll revenue obligations.

#### d. Finance

#### (1) Grimes and Montgomery Counties

Consider the approval of the SH 249 System annual budget of revenues, operating and maintenance expenses, major maintenance expenditures, and capital expenditures (MO)

This minute order approves the annual budget of revenues, operating and maintenance expenses, major maintenance expenditures, and capital expenditures for the SH 249 System (system). The Texas Transportation Commission (commission) financed a portion of the costs of the system with obligations issued pursuant to a trust agreement. The trust agreement stipulates that the commission will adopt an annual budget for the system by August 31 of the preceding fiscal year.

#### 116767

#### (2) Dallas and Denton Counties

Consider the approval of the I-35E Managed Lanes Project annual budget of revenues, operating and maintenance expenses, and capital expenditures (MO)

This minute order approves the annual budget of revenues, operating and maintenance expenses, and capital expenditures for the I-35E Managed Lanes Project (project) in Dallas and Denton counties. The Texas Transportation Commission (commission) financed a portion of the costs of the project with a Transportation Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act Ioan. The trust agreement for the Ioan stipulates that the commission will adopt an annual budget by August 31 of the preceding fiscal year.

#### (3) Travis and Williamson Counties

Consider the approval of the Central Texas Turnpike System annual operating, maintenance, and capital budgets (MO)

This minute order approves the annual operating, maintenance, and capital budgets for the Central Texas Turnpike System (CTTS) which consists of SH 130 Segments 1-4, SH45N, SH 45SE, and Loop 1 extension. Some costs of the CTTS were financed with debt obligations. The Indenture of Trust stipulates that the Texas Transportation Commission will adopt annual budgets by August 31 of the preceding fiscal year.

#### (4) Debt Management Policy

Consider the approval of the Debt Management Policy for financing programs of the Texas Transportation Commission (MO)

This minute order approves the Debt Management Policy which establishes parameters for the Texas Transportation Commission's financing programs considering acceptable levels of risk, minimizing interest costs, and optimizing future flexibility with consideration to achieving and maintaining the best possible credit ratings.

#### (5) Investment Policy and Investment Strategies

Consider the annual review and approval of the investment policy and investment strategies applicable to all funds of the Texas Transportation Commission not otherwise required to be invested by the comptroller (MO)

This minute order approves the Texas Transportation Commission's (commission) investment policy and investment strategies. The Public Funds Investment Act requires the commission to review the investment policy and investment strategies on an annual basis, and to approve by order any modifications to the investment policy and investment strategies.

#### (6) Annual Budget

Consider the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2025 Texas Department of Transportation budget (MO)

This minute order adopts the Texas Department of Transportation's annual budget as prescribed by the General Appropriations Act

#### 14. Routine Minute Orders and Reports

e. **Designation of Access Control**

**Denton County -** SH 114, in the city of Fort Worth- Consider the designation of one location on the south side of SH 114 at which access will be permitted to the abutting property (MO)

The designation of one 50-foot break in the control-of-access line will allow the abutting landowner to open one commercial driveway for access to and from the south side of SH 114. The district has determined that access may be permitted at the designated location.

#### f. Transportation Planning

- (1) SH 121 Various Counties Consider concurrence with the Regional Transportation Council of the North Central Texas Council of Governments' funding of construction and other project development costs of projects to be advanced through the use of payments received from the North Texas Tollway Authority in accordance with the SH 121 Toll Project Agreement (MO)
  - The Texas Department of Transportation has established a separate fund to account for and track projects and project costs funded with the SH 121 payments. This minute order authorizes the funding of additional project costs and changes to the list of previously approved projects. The project costs to be funded were selected through a cooperative process with the Regional Transportation Council.

(2) SH 161 - Various Counties - Consider concurrence with the Regional Transportation Council of the North Central Texas Council of Governments' funding of construction and other project development costs of projects to be advanced through the use of payments received from the North Texas Tollway Authority in accordance with the SH 161 Toll Project Agreement (MO) The Texas Department of Transportation has established a separate fund to account for and track projects and project costs funded with the SH 161 payments. This minute order authorizes changes to the list of previously approved projects.

#### g. Speed Zones

**Various Counties** - Consider the establishment or alteration of regulatory and construction speed zones on various sections of highways in the state (MO) This minute order establishes or alters regulatory and construction speed zones on various sections of highways in the state.

15. **Executive Session** Pursuant to Government Code, Chapter 551 **Section 551.071** - Consultation with and advice from legal counsel regarding any item on this agenda, pending or contemplated litigation, or other legal matters.
