In the city of Corpus Christi, Nueces County, on SS 407, the state of Texas acquired certain land for highway purposes.

All land, described in exhibits A, B, C, D, E, F, and G (tracts), is no longer needed for a state highway purpose.

In accordance with V.T.C.A., Transportation Code, Chapter 202, Subchapter B, the Texas Transportation Commission (commission) may recommend the transfer of highway right of way to a governmental entity that is assuming or has assumed jurisdiction, control, and maintenance of the right of way for public road purposes.

If the tracts are no longer used for public road purposes, if the unrestricted motor vehicle lanes are reduced in number or width, or if the capacity of the roadway is reduced at all, said real property shall immediately and automatically revert to the state of Texas.

The city of Corpus Christi, Texas, is assuming or has assumed jurisdiction, control, and maintenance and has requested that the tracts be transferred to the city of Corpus Christi, Texas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the commission that the tracts, as shown on exhibits A, B, C, D, E, F, and G, are removed from the state highway system.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the commission that the tracts are no longer needed for a state highway purpose. The commission recommends, subject to approval by the attorney general, that the governor of Texas execute a proper instrument conveying all of the state's right, title, and interest in the tracts to the city of Corpus Christi, Texas; SAVE AND EXCEPT, however, there is to be excepted and reserved therefrom all of the state's right, title, and interest, if any, in and to all of the oil, gas, sulphur, and other minerals, of every kind and character, in, on, under, and that may be produced from the land.

Line Description 1

Description of a line situated between the West line of Lot 6, Block 1, of the West End Addition recorded in Volume A, Page 5, of the Map Records of Nueces County, Texas (M.R.N.C.T.) and the West line of Lot 7, Block 10, of the Jones Addition recorded in Volume 3, Page 17 of the Map Records of Nueces County, Texas (M.R.N.C.T.), it being the intent of this line description to remove the land East of this line and within the Right of Way of Leopard Street (SS 407) (formerly known as State Highway 9) from the State Highway System and the land West of this line is to be retained by the State of Texas, said line being determined from maps and documents for Leopard Street (SS 407) on file at the Texas Department of Transportation, Corpus Christi District Headquarters in Corpus Christi, Texas and on file in the Nueces County Clerk's Office in Corpus Christi, Texas, said line being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a set Mag Nail with a washer stamped "TXDOT CONTROL" set on the South right-of-way line of Schatzell Street (SS407) and on the West right-of-way line of Water Street (SS544) (80' Right-of-Way), said Point of Beginning having grid coordinates of N = 17,179,658.13, E = 1,342,181.02:

1. THENCE, North 11°01'52" East, departing the intersection of the South right-of-way line of Schatzell Street (SS407) and the West right-of-way line of Water Street (SS544), said intersecting point also being the Northeast corner of Block 3 of the above mentioned Beach Portion, a distance of 60.33' to a set Mag Nail with a washer stamped "TXDOT CONTROL" located at the intersection of the North right-of-way line of Schatzell Street (SS407) and the West right-of-way line of Water Street (SS544), said intersecting point also being the Southeast corner of Block 4 of the above mentioned Beach Portion.

BEGINNING at a set Mag Nail with a washer stamped "TXDOT CONTROL" set on the South right-of-way line of Lawrence Street (SS407) and on the West right-of-way line of Water Street (SS544) (80' Right-of-Way), said Point of Beginning having grid coordinates of N = 17,179,312.45, E = 1,342,077.65:

1. **THENCE**, North 15°05'21" East, departing the intersection of the South right-of-way line of Lawrence Street (SS407) and the West right-of-way line of Water Street (SS544), said intersecting point also being the Northeast corner of Block 2 of the above mentioned Beach Portion, a distance of 60.03' to a calculated point (unable to set ~ point located within a decorative wall) located at the intersection of the North right-of-way line of Lawrence Street (SS407) and the West right-of-way line of Water Street (SS544), said intersecting point also being the Southeast corner of Block 3 of the above mentioned Beach Portion.

All monuments set are for TxDOT reference and are set for removing roadway from the State Highway System and are not intended for boundary corners for adjacent properties.




