KEY PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- US 75: widen from four lanes to six lanes from the Collin County Line to FM 901 -- \$93 million
- US 75 Reconstruct and improve overpasses and ramps from SH 91 to North Loy Lake Road - \$325 million
- I-30: replace/widen interchanges to six lanes at FM 1903, 1570, 1565, 36, Monty Stratton Parkway and CR 2511 - \$316 million
- FM 2642: widen to four lanes from SH 66 to FM 35 - \$30 million

PLANNED KEY PROJECTS:

- US 75: widen from four to six lanes from FM 901 to FM 1417--\$113 million
- I-30: widen from four to six lanes from FM 2642 to Monty Stratton Parkway -- \$191 million
- US 82: widen from two to four lanes from Fannin County Line to State Loop 286 – \$177 million
- US 82: Convert to freeway from Stillhouse Road to Pine Mill Road --\$156 million
- US 271: Widen from two to four lanes from Loop 286 to SH 37 -\$142 million
