KEY CORRIDOR PLANS

- I-35 Northeast Expansion (NEX): Expansion to improve I-35 between FM 1103 and N. Walters Street. I-35 NEX Central between I-410 N to FM 3009 will be completed in 2027. Phase 1 of I-35 NEX South between I-410 N and I-410 S began construction in 2024. I-35 NEX South Phase 2 and 3 will break ground in 2025. I-35 NEX North will be under construction within the next five years.
- Loop 1604: Expansion to a 10-lane expressway between SH 16 (Bandera Road) and I-35 with direct connectors at I-10. Segment 1 and 3 between SH 16 (Bandera Road) to US 281 will be completed in Summer 2025. Segment 2 at the I-10 interchange will be completed in 2027. Segment 4 from US 281 to Redland Road will be completed in 2027. Segment 5 will begin construction in Spring 2025. Segment 6 between Redland Road to I-35 will be under construction in the next five years.
- Comal County: SH 46 widening project in Spring Branch is currently under construction.
- Guadalupe County: I-10 expansion between FM 464 and SH 130 is estimated to be completed in 2029.
- Upcoming major mobility projects include US 90 Expansion and I-410/US 281/San Pedro Avenue Operational Improvement Project.

MAINTENANCE: Our maintenance budget is about \$100 million annually. Our major expenditures include pavement preservation, traffic management and roadside maintenance.

SAFETY: Our safety program focuses on reducing traffic fatalities through education, engineering and enforcement. This involves safety campaigns, roadway upgrades including pedestrian facilities and clearer pavement marking, grant funding to police agencies like our Selective Traffic Enforcement Program and the Highway Emergency Response Operator (HERO) program.
