The Tyler District plans, designs, builds, operates and maintains the state transportation system in the following counties: Anderson, Cherokee, Gregg, Henderson, Rusk, Smith, Van Zandt and Wood. The district primarily conducts asset preservation and mobility projects to ensure the safety of the traveling public.

The Tyler District has 1,198 On-System bridges and 637 Off-System bridges, for a total of 1,835 bridges.

KEY PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- **FM 2206, Gregg County:** Widen to 4 lanes from Loop 281 to Fisher Road – \$15 million (Anticipated Completion Date: Summer 2022)
- **FM 2206, Gregg County:** Widen to 4 lanes from Fisher Road to SH 42 – \$15 million (Anticipated Completion Date: Summer 2022)
- **SH 334, Henderson County:** Construct new bridge to provide four lanes from Gun Barrel City to Seven Points – \$42 million (Anticipated Completion Date: Spring 2021)
- **US 69 at FM 346, Smith County:** Construct grade-separated interchange – \$15.5 million (Anticipated Completion Date: Spring 2021)
- **FM 2493, Smith County:** Widen to 4 lanes divided with continuous left turn lane from FM 2813 in Gresham to FM 346 in Flint – \$12 million (Anticipated Completion Date: Summer 2021)

PLANNED KEY PROJECTS:

- **US 175, Anderson County:** Widen to 4 lanes from Frankston to CR 3509 – \$48 million (Letting: December 2021)
- **US 175, Cherokee County:** Widen to 4 lanes from CR 3509 to Jacksonville – \$125 million (Letting: June 2023)
- **I-20/SH 31 Interchange, Gregg County:** Remove left exits, reconfigure interchange – \$150 million (Letting: June 2025)
- **US 271, Gregg & Smith counties:** Widen to 4 lanes from FM 16 to Loop 485 in Gladewater – \$54 million (Letting: April 2023)
- **FM 2493, Smith County:** Widen to 4 lanes from FM 346 in Flint to Cherokee County Line south of Bullard – \$33 million (Letting: April 2022)

MAINTENANCE: The Tyler District spends approximately \$15 million annually on sealcoating projects. We also spend several million each year rehabilitating pavement on our interstate and US highway system.

CORRIDORS: The district's priority corridors are I-20, US 69, US 79, US 175 and SH 31.

SAFETY: The district has pursued funding for numerous safety improvement projects, including grade separations, widening of narrow roadways, adding center- and edge-line rumble strips and overlaying roadways with surface mixes that reduce wet weather accidents.
