

AASHTOWare Project Construction and Materials (APCM)

APCM is a web-based construction and materials management application that is replacing the AASHTOWare SiteManager currently being used. It is one module of AASHTOWare Project (AWP) used by TxDOT.

Access and Login

Access has been granted to users for both the Production Environment (PROD) and the Training Environment (TEST1).

- Users will login with their TxDOT Username and Password to access APCM in all environments.
- APCM supports Google Chrome. If issues occur, confirm Chrome is being utilized by the user.

PRODUCTION (PROD) ENVIRONMENT

- Users will not be able to view any projects in the PROD Environment until they are provided contract authority for a specific project.

TRAINING (TEST1) ENVIRONMENT

- Currently the link provided is the only access to this environment.
- Users are granted statewide access to work with projects in their role(s).

User Roles

User roles were granted based on existing SiteManager Roles for users. Note: All users with an Inspector role in SiteManager have been granted Project Manager access in APCM until the INSPECTOR role has completed development

Role Switching

Permissions in APCM are based on role. Users in APCM may have multiple roles.

- Users may switch roles at any time in APCM, but switching can change what is viewed on the screen based on permission for that role.
- To avoid errors, close out current tasks and return to the home screen before switching roles.

Issue Reporting

District users experiencing issues are asked to contact their District APCM Point of Contact. District APCM Points of Contact will report issues for PROD to the APCM Hypercare channel and will need the following information:

- Name
- Email
- User ID
- Role(s) being used in Production
- Description of the issue
- Screenshots are recommended.

Training Resources

Expected training resources for APCM include recorded demonstrations, job aids and job simulations (CBT), some of which are still under development.
