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Texas Transportation Commission Meeting

- Pursuant to Transportation Code, Chapter 223, Subchapter A, and Title 43, Texas
 Administrative Code, Chapter 9, Subchapter B, the Texas Department of Transportation
 (department) solicited and received sealed competitive bid proposals for improvement
 of the State Highway System, which are publicly opened and read
- Pursuant to cited code provisions highway improvement contract bids on a project may be accepted or rejected, but if accepted must be awarded to the lowest bidder
- The Commission dates are posted on the TxDOT website: <u>Commission meeting dates</u> and agendas
- A livestream starts 10 minutes before the meeting <u>Texas Department of Transportation</u>





Texas Transportation Commission Meeting cont.

- The TXDOT website is updated with the Commission's decision to Award, Reject or Defer the current month's State Let projects
- Upon the commission's decision an email will be sent to all awarded contractors to notify a contract has been mailed to the contractor's address on file via FedEx except for:
 - Pending Union Pacific Railroad Right of Entry (ROE) or Maintenance Consent Letter (MCL)
 - Conditional Award (third party participation)
 - The district will provide a Notice of Financial Clearance Form
- All State Let awarded contracts and required documents are due back within 15 calendar days as shown on the award letter
- Rejection letters are printed and mailed to contractor(s)
- Deferred projects will be held until the next commission meeting

Signature Page and System for Award Management (SAM's) Review

- Contractor's printed name, signature, title and date are present on the signature page
 - Contractor is listed as an authorized signer
 - Must be the same authorized signer(s) for all three documents (signature page, performance and payment bonds)
 - The signatures must match exactly what was identified during the prequalification paperwork denoting the authorized signers on behalf of the company
 - Printed name must accompany all signatures
 - To add an authorized signer, contact <u>CST_prequalification@txdot.gov</u>
 - Stamp signatures are NOT acceptable
 - The Business Ownership and 1295 can be signed by different authorized signers

Performance and Payment Bonds (1)

- The bond(s) in the contract must be executed by a corporate Surety company (signature, date and embossed corporate seal)
 - Surety company is authorized to write Fidelity and Surety Bonds for public works in the State of Texas
 - Surety must be listed in the current issue of the Federal Register Dept. of Treasury list
 - Have adequate bonding capacity for the size of the contract.
 - Surety must execute bonds in Ink.
- The Surety may date bonds and Powers of Attorney
 - Cannot be dated past the due date of the contract
 - Powers of Attorney, showing that the Surety's officer or attorney in fact has the authority to sign the bonding obligations
 - In addition, the surety must attach a Bond Claim Notice.
- Corporate seal of the Surety must be embossed on all bonds and the Powers of Attorney
 - · Water seals and stamp facsimile are not acceptable.

- Contracts greater than \$100,000
 - Performance bonds are not required for contracts under \$100,000
 - Payment bonds are not required for contract under \$25,000
- Maintenance Materials Contracts (MMC) and Traffic Materials Contracts (TMC)
 - 2024 Spec Book, Item 10



Warranty Bonds

- Warranty bonds are identified in the proposal by Special Specification 6064 and 6065
 - Contractor's and Manufacturer's Warranty Bonds will be mailed with the contract documents
 - Only one bond is required for the contract to be executed
- Contractor's Warranty bond will be signed
 - Contractor's authorized signer and surety's Attorney-In-Fact
- Manufacturer's Warranty bond will be signed
 - Contract's authorized signer and the manufacturer's Surety Attorney-In-Fact
- Both bonds will follow the same surety criteria for performance and payment bonds



4. EXECUTION OF CONTRACT

Provide the following within 15 days after written notification of award of the Contract.

- Contract. Execute the Contract as prescribed by the Department.
- 4.2. Bonds. Execute and date the performance and payment bond in the full amount of the Contract with the powers of attorney. Provide bonds in accordance with Table 1. Furnish the payment and performance bonds as a guaranty for the protection of the claimants and the Department for labor and materials and the faithful performance of the work.

4.3. Insurance. Submit a certificate of insurance showing coverages in accordance with Contract requirements.

Insurances must cover the work for the duration of the Contract and must remain in effect until final acceptance. Failure to obtain and maintain insurance for the contracted work may result in suspension of work or default of the Contract. If the insurance expires and coverage lapses for any reason, stop all work until the Department receives an acceptable certificate of insurance.

4.3. Insurance. For construction and building Contracts, submit a certificate of insurance showing coverages in accordance with the Contract requirements. For routine maintenance Contracts, refer to Article 3.8., "Beginning of Work."

Insurances must cover the work for the duration of the Contract and must remain in effect until final acceptance. Provide project-specific insurance, not listed in Table 2, until acceptance of the work covered by the project-specific insurance or as approved by the Engineer. Failure to obtain and maintain insurance for the contracted work may result in suspension of work or default of the Contract. If the insurance expires and coverage lapses for any reason, stop all work until the Department receives an acceptable certificate of insurance.
