Approaching a Roundabout

Emergency Vehicles

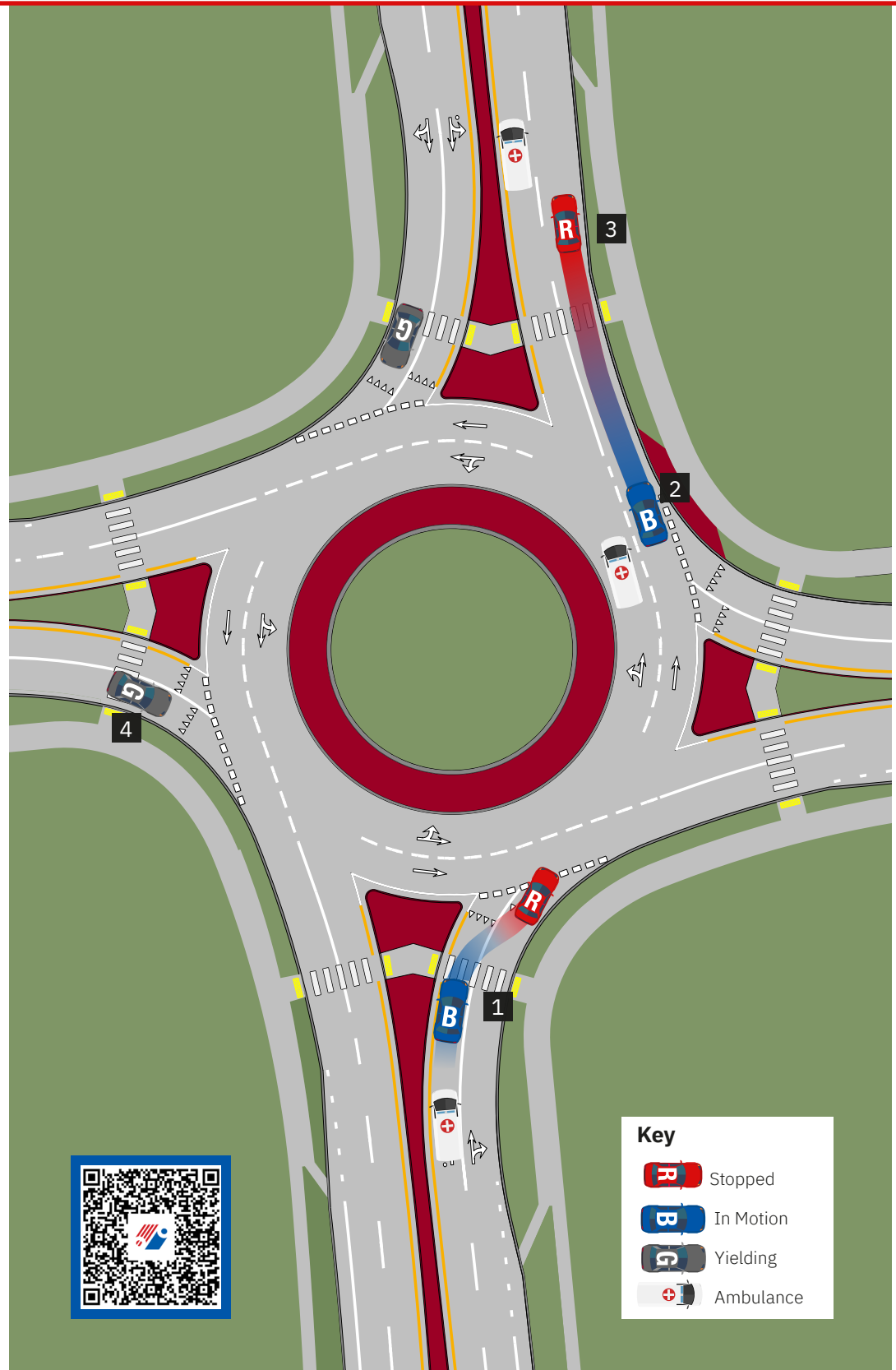
By law, drivers must pull over for emergency vehicles.

In roundabouts, drivers must clear a roundabout if they hear (or see) an emergency vehicle coming.

Do not enter a roundabout if you notice an emergency vehicle approaching.

Drivers inside a roundabout should exit as soon as possible, then pull over.

- 1** Before entering the roundabout, move to the right so emergency vehicles can pass.
- 2** If you're already in the roundabout, do not stop because the emergency vehicle may not be able to pass.
- 3** After you exit the roundabout, move to the right and stop so emergency vehicles can pass.
- 4** Do not enter a roundabout when an emergency vehicle is approaching from another direction.
