The following manufacturers of traffic buttons have complied with the requirements of Departmental Material Specification (DMS)-8241.

The materials listed below are qualified for use when DMS-8241 is referenced. These materials require no further testing before use unless deemed necessary by the Project Engineer or the Materials and Tests Division (MTD). Tex-732-I, "Sampling Prefabricated Pavement Marking Materials," describes the sampling method.

The Department reserves the right to conduct random sampling of qualified materials for testing and to perform random audits of test reports. Department representatives may sample material from the manufacturing plants, project sites, and warehouses. MTD reserves the right to test samples to verify compliance with DMS-8241.

A Federal Domestic Materials Program (FDMP) (formerly referred to as Buy America/BABA) Status of "Compliant v4" indicates the manufacturer has certified that the model, product, or material listed complies with applicable contract requirements, as reflected through TxDOT's Gold Star Program and classified in accordance with the FDMP Material Classification Sheet. This status applies to projects federally obligated

on or after October 1, 2025, and before October 1, 2026, commonly referred to as the Phase 1 implementation period.

A FDMP Status of "Compliant v5" indicates the manufacturer has certified that the model, product, or material listed complies with applicable contract requirements, as reflected through TxDOT's Gold Star Program and classified in accordance with the FDMP Material Classification Sheet. This status applies to projects federally obligated on or after October 1, 2026, commonly referred to as the Phase 2 implementation period.

A FDMP Status of "Project Level Certification Required" indicates the product is not currently part of the Gold Star Program and requires FDMP documentation to be submitted and verified at the project level in accordance with contract requirements until such time as the product is reviewed and approved for Gold Star participation.
