1.	In the pilot project guidance, it's noted that all signed and sealed plan deliverables will be in model format (MALD), developed in ProjectWise, and submitted via iTwin. However, TxDOT digital delivery resources primarily reference Bentley Infrastructure Cloud rather than iTwin. Could you please clarify whether iTwin is the intended platform for model-based submittals, or if Bentley Infrastructure Cloud will be used as the delivery mechanism?	Yes, iTwin/Infrastructure Cloud are synonymous and are the intended platform.
2.	During the pre-RFP meeting, it was mentioned that sheets may also be requested. Could you elaborate on what is meant by this—specifically, under what circumstances sheets might be requested and what format or content those sheets would include?	If selected for the contract and authorized for work, roll-plot or plan sheets may be requested for internal supplemental department use. The format would follow PS&E manual guidelines.
