  - Item 2 Instructions to Bidders
  - Item 3 Award and Execution of Contract
- These advertised projects require a specification book, which is then included in the resulting contract.



## **Spec Book Relevance**

- §201.053(b)(7) Texas Transportation Code
- Maximize federal funding
  - Highways
  - Public Transportation
  - Aviation purposes
    - General Appropriations Act (GAA), S.B. 1, 83rd Texas Legislature, Regular Session, 2013
- Articles and Sections. The basic Articles required for a specification are:

1. DESCRIPTION

- 2. MATERIALS
- 3. EQUIPMENT
- 4. CONSTRUCTION OR WORK METHODS
- 5. MEASUREMENT
- 6. PAYMENT

#### 3. Definitions

**3.6 Affiliates.** Two or more firms Bidders are affiliated if they share common officers, directors, or stockholders; a family member of an officer, director, or stockholder of one firm Bidder serves in a similar capacity in another of the firms Bidders; an individual who has an interest in, or controls a part of, one firm Bidder either directly or indirectly also has an interest in, or controls a part of, another of the firms Bidders; the firms Bidders are so closely connected or associated that one of the firms Bidders, either directly or indirectly, controls or has the power to control another firm Bidder; one firm Bidder controls or has the power to control another firm Bidder; one firm Bidder controls or has the power to control another of the firms Bidder; or the firms Bidders are closely allied through an established course of dealings, including, but not limited to, the lending of financial assistance. Refer to 43 TAC § 9.12(g), "Affiliated Entities."

**3.19 Bidders Questionnaire.** A prequalification form completed by a prospective Bidder reflecting a Bidder's that reflects detailed equipment and experience data but waives audited financial data and experience.

3.32 Confidential Questionnaire. A pregualification form that reflects detailed financial and experience data.
