Locally Named Memorial Highways

Memorial Highways pay tribute to notable people or groups and can be designated by the state or by local governments. State-designated Memorial Highways are designated by the Texas Legislature and typically get 2 signs that TxDOT is responsible for maintaining. Chapter 225 of the Transportation code shows the list of legislated memorial highways and is updated after each legislative session. Any local government can designate a memorial highway; however, in order to install signage on TxDOT right of way, the proposed designation must be approved by the TxDOT Commission or Executive Director.

This map reflects the designations through the 88th legislative session, which concluded in 2023. The map will be updated again at the conclusion of the 89th legislative session in 2025.
