

Texas Motor Vehicle Traffic Crash Facts Calendar Year 2025

- The Fatality Rate on Texas roadways for 2025 was 1.20 deaths per hundred million vehicle miles traveled. This is a 10.97% decrease from 2024.
- Texas experienced a decrease in the number of motor vehicle traffic fatalities. The 2025 death toll of 3,769 was a decrease of 9.38% from the 4,159 deaths recorded in 2024.
- There were 14,396 serious injury crashes in Texas in 2025 with 17,420 people sustaining a serious injury*.
- The annual vehicle miles traveled in Texas during 2025 reached 314.006 billion, an increase of 1.79% over the 308.481 billion traveled in 2024.
- Fatalities in traffic crashes in rural areas of the state accounted for 50.12% of the state's traffic fatalities. There were 1,889 deaths in rural traffic crashes.
- Single vehicle, run-off the road crashes resulted in 1,201 deaths in 2025. This was 31.87% of all motor vehicle traffic deaths in 2025.
- In 2025 there were 955 people killed in crashes occurring in intersections or related to an intersection.
- There were 555 people killed in head-on crashes in 2025.
- There were no deathless days on Texas roadways in 2025.
- There were no crashes that resulted in 6 or more fatalities in 2025.
- Friday, July 25th was the deadliest day in 2025 with twenty-five (25) persons killed in traffic crashes. March was the deadliest month with 380 persons killed.
- Based on reportable crashes in 2025:
 - ▢ **1 person was killed every 2 hours 19 minutes**
 - ▢ **1 person was injured every 2 minutes 9 seconds**
 - ▢ **1 reportable crash occurred every 59 seconds**
- Of all persons killed in vehicles where restraint usage was applicable and usage was known in 2025, 45.94% were reported as not restrained when the fatal crash occurred.
- 244,534 persons were injured in motor vehicle traffic crashes in 2025.
- There were 559 motorcyclists (operators and passengers) killed in 2025. Thirty-one percent (31%) of motorcyclists killed were not wearing helmets at the time of the crash.
- Pedestrian fatalities totaled 695 in 2025. This is a 10.09% decrease from 2024.
- Pedalcyclist fatalities totaled 91 in 2025. This is a 13.75% increase from 2024.
- In 2025, there were 906 people killed in motor vehicle traffic crashes where a driver was under the influence of alcohol. This is 24.04% of the total number of people killed in motor vehicle traffic crashes.
- During 2025, more DUI - Alcohol crashes were reported in the hour between 2:00 am and 2:59 am than any other hour of the day. Also, more of these crashes occurred on Saturday than any other day of the week.
- In 2025, there were 308 people killed in crashes involving distracted driving. This is an 18.95% decrease from 2024.
- There were no fatalities caused by a bridge collapse in 2025.

*Effective with the 2010 Annual Summary reports, the definition of "Serious Injury" was changed to only include "Incapacitating Injury". Therefore, Serious Injury data cannot be compared to prior years.
