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SP002-001 for Standalone ITS Projects

Special Provision to Item 2 ([SP002-001](#)) may be used in standalone intelligent transportation systems (ITS) projects. A standalone ITS project is defined as a project in which *more than 50%* of the work involves installing ITS equipment such as CCTV cameras, dynamic message signs, radar detection systems, and communications.

To identify which categories are included in the standalone ITS project, a select subset of or all the following accompanying triple-zero Important Notice to Contractors special provisions should be used. For example, if the project involves installing CCTV cameras, SP000-010 and SP000-012 should be included.

- 000-008 – Category A: Pulling Fiber Optic Cable
- 000-009 – Category B: Splicing and Testing of Fiber Optic Cable
- 000-010 – Category C: System Integration
- 000-011 – Category D: Dynamic Message Sign
- 000-012 – Category E: CCTV Equipment Installation
- 000-013 – Category F: Wireless Communications
- 000-014 – Category G: Radar Detection Systems

Bidders need to be on the ITS technically qualified bidders list *prior* to *letting* for their bids to be considered responsive in statewide construction lettings. For more

SP000-015 for Non-Standalone ITS Projects

Special Provision [000-015](#) may be used in non-standalone ITS projects. A non-standalone ITS project is defined as a roadway construction project or a routine maintenance contract (RMC) where *less than 50%* of the work involves installing ITS equipment. The experience requirements in SP000-015 are consistent with SP002-001. While SP000-015 lists requirements for all categories, only the requirements for the categories included in the project must be met. Bidders do not need to be on the ITS technically qualified bidders list. The District verifies the contractor's qualification and experience post-letting.
