## PURPOSE AND NEED

The purpose of the proposed project is to bring the roadway up to current design standards, and to reduce congestion and improve mobility along FM 455 within the project limits. The proposed project is needed due to the current insufficient transportation network in the project vicinity and to accommodate the increased demand.

## PROJECT DETAILS

**Limits:** From West of FM 2450 to East of Marion Road, City of Sanger, Denton County, Texas

**CSJ:** 0816-02-072

**Description:** Reconstruct and widen FM 455 facility from a 2-lane rural highway to a 4-lane divided urban.

**Estimated Let Date:** August 2022

**Total Length:** 5.53 miles

## PROJECT STATUS

The proposed project was environmentally cleared in 2018. Right-of-Way acquisition was completed in 2019. Archeologists have uncovered artifacts within the limits of the project area at two identified sites. Further investigation and testing of these sites are currently under investigation to determine National Register eligibility.

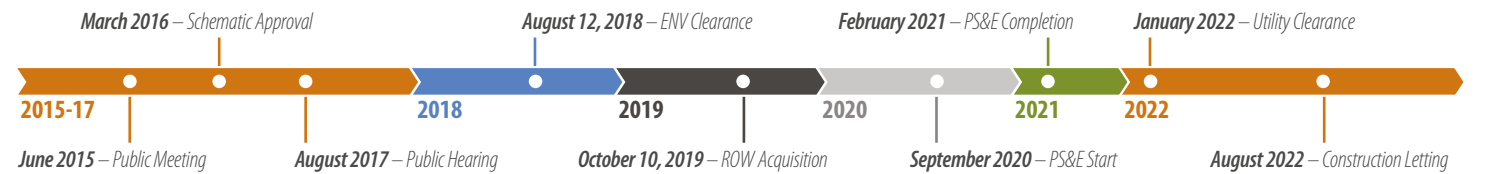

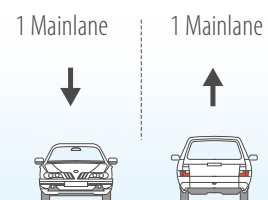

## PROJECT TIMELINE

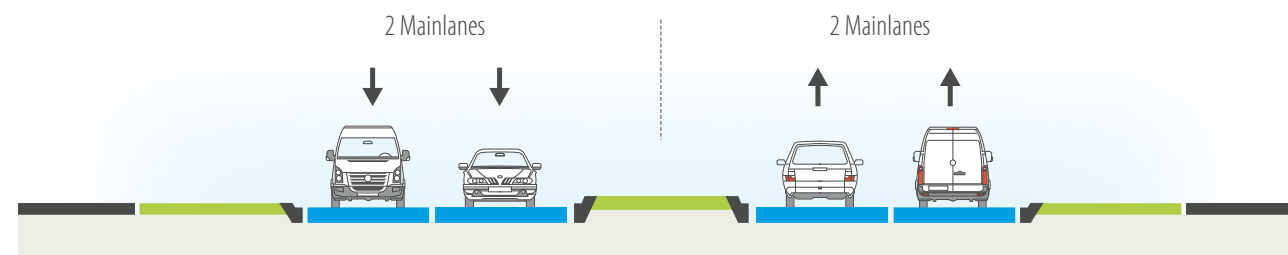


## EXISTING TYPICAL SECTION
