
#### Introduction

A Utility Owner must apply for a permit with TxDOT when they need to install a new facility on TxDOT Right of Way, to perform maintenance on a facility on TxDOT Right of Way, or to perform an adjustment to a facility on TxDOT Right of Way required due to a transportation project. If a utility permit is related to a TxDOT roadway project, the Utility Owner or Utility Consultant will need to enter the TxDOTCONNECT Utility ID when creating the utility permit. Entering the TxDOTCONNECT Utility ID on the utility permit will create the connection between the TxDOT roadway project in TxDOTCONNECT and the utility permit in RULIS.



### **RULIS and TxDOTCONNECT Workflow**








#### **Utilities Details Table from TxDOTCONNECT**

The TxDOT Utility Coordinator will add the utility in TxDOTCONNECT, creating a TxDOTCONNECT Utility ID. It is the responsibility of the TxDOT Utility Coordinator to provide the Utility Owner with the TxDOTCONNECT Utility ID.



## **Project Information Screen from RULIS**

The Utility Owner or Utility Consultant will receive the TxDOTCONNECT Utility ID from their Utility Coordinator so they can enter that on their utility permit in RULIS when the permit is first created in RULIS. If the Utility Owner or Utility Consultant has not received the TxDOTCONNECT Utility ID, they will need to contact their District Utility Coordinator to receive this information.





A Utility Installation Permit Application should be associated to 1 TxDOTCONNECT Utility ID






# Permit Information, Adjustments Begin & Completion Dates from TxDOTCONNECT

After a utility permit with a TxDOTCONNECT Utility ID is created in RULIS, the connection between RULIS and TxDOTCONNECT is established, and the following will take place:

- The RULIS utility permit application number is sent to TxDOTCONNECT.
- When the utility permit is approved in RULIS, the RULIS utility permit approval date is sent to TxDOTCONNECT.
- When the begin and end construction dates are entered or updated on the utility permit in RULIS, those dates are sent to TxDOTCONNECT.
