TRAFFIC ALERT

April 24, 2020

HOUSTON – As the IH 610 Cambridge project moves forward, there will be several total lane closures taking place this weekend beginning at 8 p.m. Friday, April 24 through 5 a.m. Tuesday, April 28.

The IH 610 South Loop eastbound mainlanes from Almeda Rd. to Scott St. will close from 8 p.m. on Friday, April 24 through 5:00 a.m. Sunday, April 26

• Motorists will be detoured to the FM 521/Almeda Rd. exit and on to the IH 610 frontage road and will re-enter the mainlanes at the Scott St. entrance ramp.

The IH 610 South Loop Eastbound Direct Connector to SH 288 Northbound and Southbound will also be closed from 8 p.m. on Friday, April 24 through 5:00 a.m. Sunday, April 26

 Motorists will be detoured to the FM 521/Almeda Rd.exit and on to the IH 610 frontage road where they will make a u-turn at Scott St. on to the IH 610 westbound mainlanes to access SH 288 northbound and southbound.

The SH 288 northbound direct connector to IH 610 South Loop eastbound will be closed from 8 p.m. on Friday, April 24 through 5:00 a.m. Sunday, April 26

 Motorists will proceed on SH 288 northbound to IH-69 northbound to IH 45 southbound back to the IH 610 South Loop.

The SH 288 southbound direct connector to IH 610 eastbound will also be closed from 8 p.m. on Friday, April 24 through 5:00 a.m. Sunday, April 26

 Motorists will be detoured to IH 610 westbound where they will make a u-turn at Scott St. on to the IH 610 eastbound mainlanes.

The S. Post Oak Rd., Stella Link Rd., Buffalo Speedway, Kirby Dr. and Fannin St. eastbound entrance ramps will also be closed during these times.

Motorists should expect delays and may want to consider an alternate route. Police officers will be onsite to assist with traffic control.

The \$116 million Texas Clear Lanes project will offer traffic congestion relief and increase mobility with the reconstruction of mainlanes, frontage roads and the addition of a freeway overpass and eight direct connector tie-ins to SH 288.
