

Expect delays along I-635E between Abrams Rd. and Forest Ln. Aug. 5-6

Includes overnight closure of all I-635E mainlanes and overpass bridges

DALLAS – As part of the ongoing I-635E improvement project, there will be major impacts to traffic on the interstate and cross streets this weekend.

- All lanes along eastbound and westbound I-635E between Abrams Road and Forest Lane will be closed beginning Saturday evening, August 5 at 8 p.m. through Sunday morning, August 6 at noon. Drivers will be detoured to the frontage roads to access the next available entrance ramp onto the mainlanes. (Refer to *Exhibit A* below)
- Both directions of Abrams Road and Forest Lane cross street bridges at I-635E will be closed during this time, detouring traffic through the alternate streets: Abrams Road, Audelia Road, Royal Lane, and Walnut Street. (Refer to *Exhibit B* below)
- All lanes along Markville Drive at the eastbound I-635 frontage road will also be closed. Drivers will be detoured to Greenville Avenue and Royal Lane to access the next entrance ramp. (Refer to *Exhibit B* below)

Drivers should expect delays, seek alternate routes or plan for extra travel time. All scheduled work and closures are subject to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
