West Cliffs Stabilization Project





FACT SHEET

Loop 360 is a major north/south transportation corridor for the capital area region, acting as a thoroughfare and commuter route for residents in west Austin as well as those passing through. The 14-mile corridor runs from US 183 on the north end to US 290/SH 71 on the south end.

West Cliffs Stabilization Project Overview

In May 2024, a rockslide on the west side of Loop 360 damaged the limestone cliffs. Excavation of this area is a component of the Courtyard/RM 2222 project. This work will remove 155,000 cubic yards prior to Courtyard/RM 2222 project 2026 start date.

Construction is anticipated to begin in fall 2025 to accommodate migratory birds.

Courtyard Drive/RM 2222 Project Overview

The purpose of the project is to improve mobility and safety at the Loop 360 intersections of Courtyard Drive and RM 2222.

Proposed solutions for the intersections include:



Remove traffic signal from Loop 360 mainlanes at Courtyard Drive and construct an underpass.



Reconfigure RM 2222 at Loop 360 to a diverging diamond interchange (DDI).



Add shareduse paths and sidewalks within the project limits.



Details and Timeline

The Courtyard Drive/RM 2222 project was environmentally cleared in spring 2021 and is now in the utility relocation phase.

Construction is anticipated to begin in 2026.
