• Project Details:

- Add two non-tolled managed lanes in both directions.
- Reconstruct and widen east-west crossings (bridges) at: Manor Road, Dean Keeton Street, 32nd Street, 38 1/2 Street and Wilshire Boulevard.
- Reconstruct the Airport Boulevard intersection.
- Construct a new Red Line bridge.
- Add a pedestrian-only bridge at Capital Plaza.
- Final design underway.
- Anticipated construction start: 2027
- Contractor: To be determined








Drainage Tunnel and Pump Station

- Limits: Airport Boulevard to Holly Street; Cesar Chavez Street to US 183
- Length: approx. 6.5 miles
- Details:
 - Install and mine two drainage tunnels.
 - Construct pump station.
 - Install access shafts along I-35 corridor.
- Anticipated construction start: Mid-2025





Noise Walls

- Overview of process:
 - FEIS (August 2023) proposes temporary and permanent noise walls along northbound I-35, near Cherrywood NA.
 - Late 2024: TxDOT performs feasibility and constructability analyses.
 - Mid-2025 (tentative): TxDOT to host noise wall workshop.
- Noise walls near Cherrywood NA:
 - (Proposed permanent) Northbound I-35 between 30th Street and 38th ¹/₂ Street
 - (Temporary) Northbound I-35 between 32nd Street and Edgewood Avenue

Corridor Preparations

- TxDOT is currently acquiring and clearing properties along the Central project corridor.
- Process for clearing:
 - Possession is acquired.
 - Tenants/owners relocated.
 - Environmental testing (asbestos) and abatement, as needed.
 - Utilities disconnected from structures.
 - Structures removed.

Unhoused Outreach


- Securing Vacant Properties (TxDOT):
 - Properties are secured.
 - Expedited clearing process.
- Addressing Occupants (Partners):
 - Navigation Services: Conduct the initial outreach and connect with support services.
 - APD/DPS: Supports initial outreach services and facilitates relocation of individuals.





Design update to I-35 at Wilshire Boulevard

- A "right-in, right-out" intersection.
- Wilshire Boulevard/41st Street access to be left only.
