## **Finding of No Significant Impact** for a FHWA Project

Proposed Action:I-35 Capital Express SouthProject Limits:From: US 290W/SH 71 to SH 45SECity: Austin and BudaCounty:Travis and Hays CountiesState: TexasTxDOT CSJ(s):CSJ No. 0015-13-077 & 0016-01-113

In accordance with 23 CFR Section 771.119 and Section 771.121, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and FHWA have determined that I-35 Capital Express South will not have a significant impact on the human or natural environment.

This Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the Preferred Alternative is based on the final Environmental Assessment (EA) dated December 2021 and the entire project record. This decision documents the selection of the Build Alternative (Alternative 2), presented in the final EA as the Preferred Alternative, which is described as:

The project would add two non-tolled high-occupancy managed lanes in each direction along Interstate-35 (I-35) from United States 290 (US 290) West/State Highway 71 (SH 71) to SH 45 Southeast (SE). The managed lanes would be elevated from north of Stassney Lane to south of William Cannon Drive. Additionally, the project would reconstruct bridges, add auxiliary lanes, improve bicycle and pedestrian accommodations along I-35 frontage roads, and includes other safety and mobility improvements. The facility consists of a separated concrete barrier and three to four, 11- to 12-foot wide mainlanes, two, 11- to 12-foot wide managed lanes, a 4-foot to 10-foot wide outside shoulder, 4-foot to 10-foot wide inside shoulder, two to three, 11-foot wide frontage road lanes, and a SUP in each direction. A 4-foot wide buffer would separate the mainlanes from the managed lanes. The ROW would typically be 300 to 420 feet wide. Storm sewer is included to convey stormwater and will replace the ditches in some places. Curb and gutter would be added to frontage roads. The project would require approximately 13.45 acres of additional ROW, including approximately 0.68 acre of permanent drainage easement and 0.89 acres of floodplain management area. The project would require 3.15 acres of temporary construction easements and would require utility relocations. More detailed information on ingress and egress points, and the location of auxiliary lanes can be found in the Final EA, dated December 2021.

A Notice of Availability of the draft EA was issued on April 11, 2021.

A public hearing for this project was held on April 27, 2021 in person and virtually from April 27, 2021 through May 26, 2021.

No changes to the draft EA were made as a result of comments received on the draft EA during the posted comment period or from comments made at the public hearing.

Public Hearing Documentation has been prepared and is available for review on request.

The final EA and technical reports contained in the file of record have been independently evaluated by TxDOT and determined to adequately and accurately discuss the need, purpose, alternatives, environmental issues, impacts of the proposed project, and appropriate mitigation measures. These documents provide sufficient evidence and analysis for determining that preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement is not required. These documents are incorporated by reference into this decisional document.

## Finding of No Significant Impact for a FHWA Project

Based upon TxDOT's review and consideration of the analysis and evaluation contained in the EA for this project, and after careful consideration of all social, economic, and environmental factors, including input from the public involvement process, TxDOT hereby issues this Finding of No Significant Impact for the I-35 Capital Express South project from US 290W/SH 71 to SH 45SE.

TxDOT will ensure adherence and completion of all project commitments described in the final EA December 2021, Section 8. TxDOT will ensure that any and all local, state, or federal permit requirements and conditions are met and otherwise complied with.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and the Memorandum of Understanding dated December 9, 2019, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.
