



TxDOT's new CCIS system is here! The improved dashboard and reporting, new functionality, and user experience enhancements are all designed with you in mind!

What's Changed?

- No more manual validation, via sources outside the system.
- No more disqualification due to incomplete fields (which could have proactively been flagged and addressed) as the system will prompt you when information is missing.
- No more digging to view your status and see if employees are certified.
- No more manual reports.

It's All in the Dash

As you create a precertification request, you will be able to access your dashboard and view your precertification status and other targeted information with ease. This saves time while providing targeted information. By minimizing the number of systems needed to access information, the process is streamlined and shortened.

Automation & Integration Perks

The new system brings a reduction in effort, time, and possible errors. Examples include:

- Auto population of Administrative Qualifications (AQ) system based on the information entered.
- Real time data updates regarding firm and employee status including when employees leave.
- Ease of saving, editing application drafts and addressing application issues without starting over.

Step-By-Step Training

Comprehensive training on the new system is coming soon. STEP training will cover:

- **S**ystem Navigation (General)
- **T**asks Execution by Role & Technology (Integrations)
- **E**-Communications / Notices
- **P**luses (Other Business Wins)
